

Race report Round 1 in Mülheim 2019 - „Slotracing Mülheim“

From 05.-07.04.2019 the "LMP Pro Series" started its 5th season. As in the previous year, the season opening was driven in Mülheim. In terms of mood and atmosphere, the season opener was a real highlight. From the official practice day, through the Thursday before the race to Sunday, everything was perfect. Thank you to all who contributed!

New teams have been well integrated into the "LMP Pro Series" community, for example "Damstredet Racing" felt so comfortable at their premiere that maybe there will be 2 Norwegian teams in Liège.

In the "LMP Pro Series" the fastest 1:24 model cars, in team, in two days and a night race are driven. The demands on drivers and technology are correspondingly high. As in 1:1 motorsport, it is also in 1:24 slot racing, less extravagant racing classes are able to reach many people more easily. Therefore, we are very proud to have a constant starting field in the 5th year "LMP Pro Series".

Interesting is the development of the "LMP Pro Series". Sebastian has published a little statistics in the "LMP Pro Series" Facebook group.

There were many possible winners for the "Best of Show" trophy. The track was well prepared from the host. The track grip was constant from Thursday to Sunday.

At the top there was the tightest qualification of the "LMP Pro Series" history. Paul for "GP Slot Racing" wins with 0.001s ahead of Sebastian for "Plastikquäler". But many other positions were decided only by a few thousandths of a second, too.

As a surprise, both Trier teams ("Jäger Team" and "RCT1") were really strong during the qualification.

As always, the "Best of Show" competition was chosen democratically by all teams. For the first time a "PQ" vehicle could win this trophy. Sebastian was very happy. Especially, because a highlight of the new Mazda DPI 2019 is visible only while driving, the lighting system counts in total 15 LEDs!
